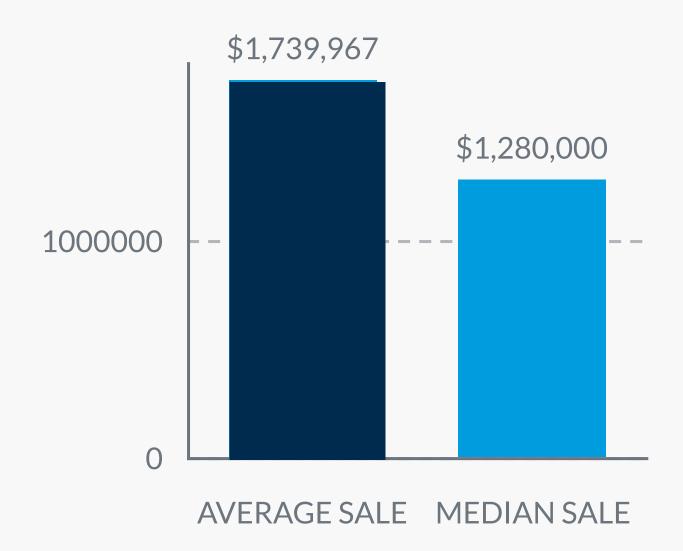
HOME PRICES OCTOBER 2025



MISC STAT & FACTS

61% of all Bainbridge Island home sales and 57% of all condo sales were to all CASH buyers

Prices per square foot ranged from \$351 to \$1,056. **The average was \$568.**

Sold homes ranged in size from 1,384 to 5,160 square feet.
The average was 2,899 SF.

Home sales ranged from 88.6% to 103.5% of seller's asking price

The average was 97.8%

78% of homes sold for \$1,000,000 or more.



SALES

There were 23 home sales on Bainbridge Island in October, which was an 8% decrease YOY and 30% decrease MOM. Prior to 2020, the change from September to October was usually negligible, but this year's drop is dramatic. The good news, however, is there were 29 pending sales which was a MOM increase of 45%, albeit a 14.7% YOY decrease. October usually sees a surge of pending sales as the last push of buyers before the holiday slowdown, and this year's number was about normal for the 5-years prior to 2020.

INVENTORY

There were 33 news listings brought to the market in October, which was an increase of 22% MOM but a 20% decrease YOY. The 59 active listings was a decrease over September, as inventory continued its seasonal contraction. The 2.6 Months of Inventory suggests a seller's market, but I will maintain my opinion from the last few months that we have transitioned to more of a buyer's market than the sellers want to accept.

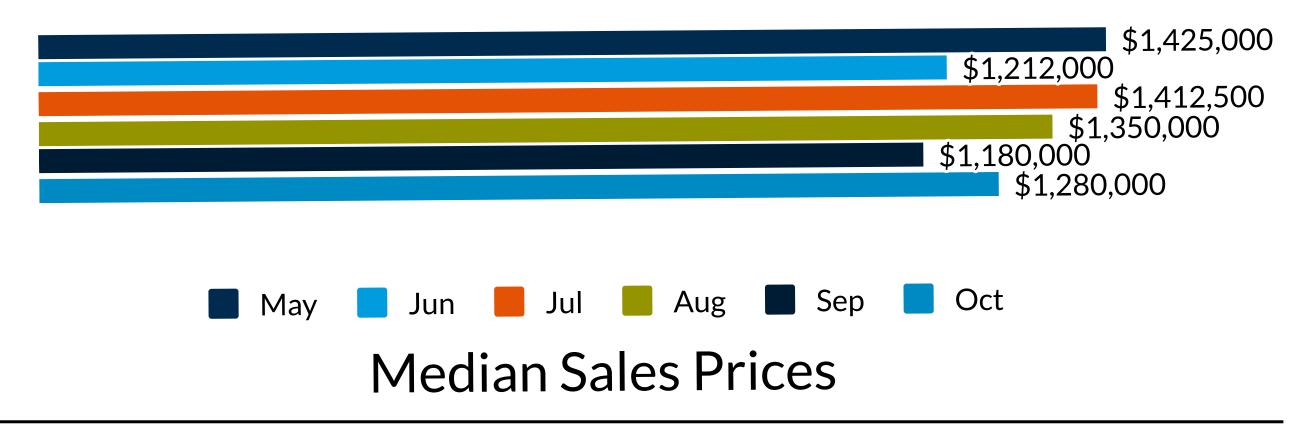
DAYS ON MARKET

Of the 23 homes that sold in October, only 6 sold in about a week or less and did so for an average of 0.5% over asking price (five of the six sold for asking price and the other one sold for 3.5% over). The other 17 homes sold in an average of 75 days and did so for an average of 96.8% of seller's asking price and 92.8% of the original asking price. The key takeaway here: sellers need to anticipate negotiating their asking price and not expect a quick sale for over asking price with multiple offers.

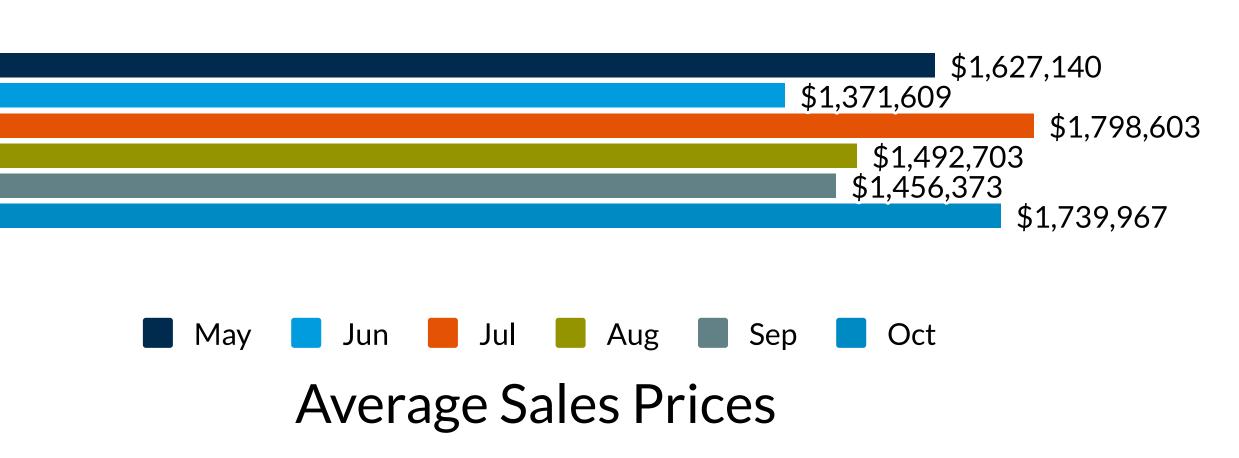


PRICING TRENDS ON BAINBRIDGE: LAST 6 MONTHS

MEDIAN: Half of the homes on Bainbridge Island sold for more than \$1,280,000 in October, and half sold for less.



AVERAGE: Prices vary widely on Bainbridge Island on a monthly basis given the wide range of prices and small sample sizes.

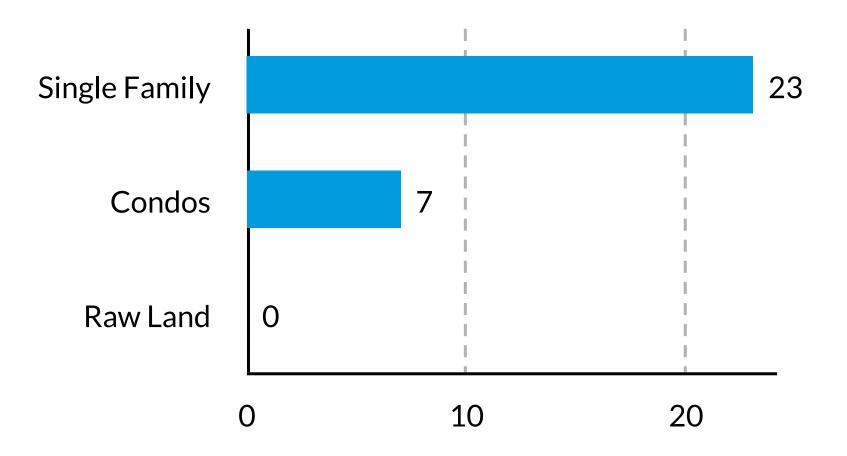
FINDINGS FROM THE FIELD

Bainbridge Island's housing market continued its cooling as we head into the holiday season.

With October marking a 30% drop in closed sales and only one home selling over asking price, we have the data to show that buyers have more negotiating power as sellers face longer listing times, fewer multiple offer more financing and inspection contingencies and lower sale prices.

Despite the slowdown, average sale prices are down just 1.8% year-to-date—far less than last year's 5.6% decline. Historically, the market has always rebounded after periods of cooling, and there is no reason to believe this cycle will be any different.

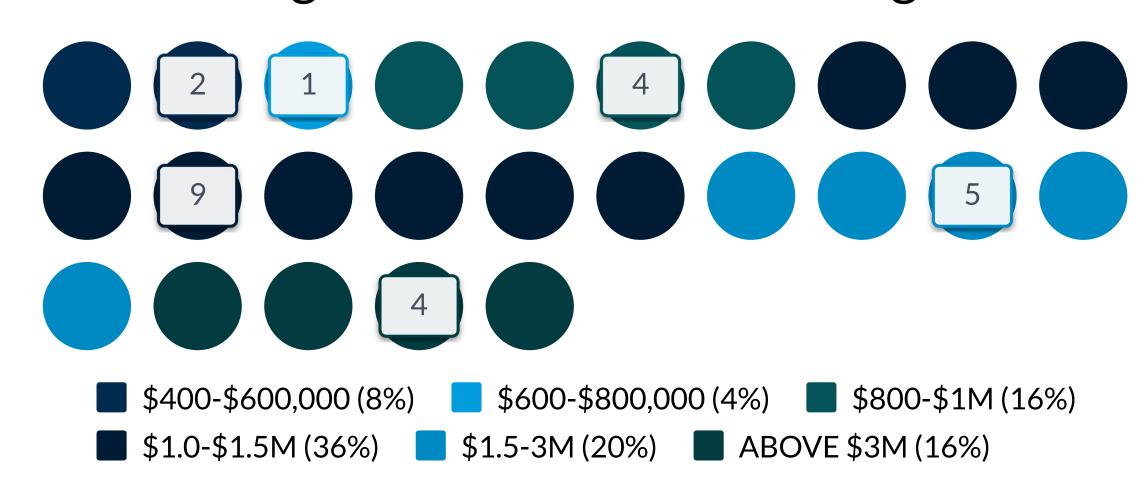
