367 SINGLE FAMILY HOMES SOLD totaling \$322,270,233—the first time annual sales volume has topped \$300M. The average sale price was also a new record at \$878,121, only the second time this number has surpassed \$800K (\$820,569 in 2007).

The 929 Active Listings was the second-lowest on record, though it was 22.8% higher than record-low 2015. Still, with just 2.7 months of supply and the acceleration of regional population growth, the limited number of available homes is great news for Sellers.




