OUICK SNAPSHOT

Sales



10 SINGLE FAMILY HOMES SOLD, the lowest monthly total ever with exception of 8/9 in Jan/Feb of 2008—the winter after the market crash. The sales volume of \$7.87M is, also, almost a record low.

Inventory



GOOD GRIEF: Only 25 New Listings is bad news—we keep hoping to see new supply come online to meet the pent up demand, but this number is a record low for February. The 29 Pending Listings is typical for the month, and the 62 Active Listings was flat from January.

Days on Market



DOM for January's sales ranged from 7 to 265, with only 3 of 10 sales having reached agreement with Buyer in less than a month. Every one of these 10 homes sold for less than original list price.

Median: half the homes sold for more than \$763,500 and half sold for less.

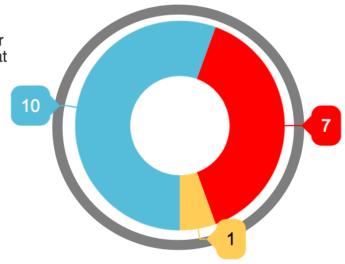
Type of Real Estate Sold on Bainbridge

Single Family

February saw a 1905 farmhouse sell on New Sweden for \$985K after a complete remodel that had the home feeling like it was brand new—while maintaining its historic charm.

A 632 sqft cabin near the end of "The Spit" sold for \$548K for 50' of waterfront on both the inside and outside beaches.

Prices per square foot this month ranged from \$205-815.



Condos

Two town home units (no shared walls) sold in the low/mid \$500's—both had 3 bedrooms and 3 bathrooms and were about 1800 sqft.

Raw Land

A 4.9 acre lot on Ridge Lane near Winslow sold for \$498,000 after 6 months on the market and an original asking price of \$560.000.





FAST FACT: For the first time that I can remember, no homes sold this month above the Seller's asking price. And the only two that sold for exactly asking price were by Sellers that made dramatic price reductions to "find the market". So though the Sale/List ratios are 100%, the Sale/Original List are 72% and 88%.
