### **QUICK SNAPSHOT**

#### Sales



16 SINGLE FAMILY HOMES SOLD, which is about average for January for as long as we have records (2003). However, sales volume for the month was \$15.3M, sixty-two percent greater than the average over the same time period. Prices are up, to say the least.

## **Inventory**



A BIT OF GOOD NEWS: The 60 Active Listings this month was the highest January since the 100 of 2013. Though the 24 Pending sales are normal for this month, the 3.5 Months Supply is the second lowest January on record.

# Days on Market



DOM for January's sales ranged from 6 to 231. Only one home sold in less than a week for a sale price above Seller's asking price. The average sale price was for 98.3% of list price after an average of 70 DOM, highlighting easier negotiations for Buyers in the winter.

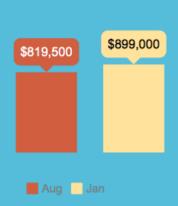

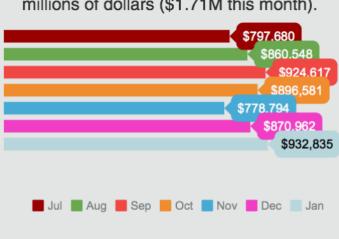
# 6-Month Pricing Trends on Bainbridge

Average prices vary widely every month given the range of sale prices can be millions of dollars (\$1.71M this month).



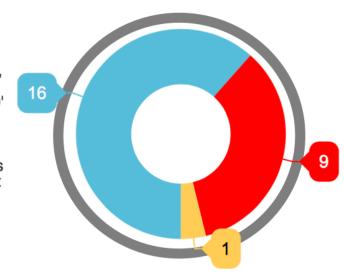
Average Home Price

# **Single Family**

This month saw several unique properties sell— Japanese architecture, a rare double lot on Rockaway Beach (120' waterfront), a new contemporary home that looks like a cube and a rambler that was over 100' long and just 25' wide.

Prices per square foot this month ranged from \$165 to \$927.



# **Condos**

All but one of these nine units sold at 100% of Seller's asking price, despite the average Days On Market being 39. Some price reductions did help Sellers find Buyers.

### Raw Land

A 0.3 acre lot in Winslow near Rotary Ball Fields sold for \$250,000– this was 11% over asking price in just 3 Days On Market.





FAST FACT: A waterfront home with epic views of the Olympic Mtns. sold for 100% of asking price after 231 days on market. What's notable here is the Seller lowered the price four times before finding the Buyer. This is an example of a Seller setting the initial list price way too high and having to "chase the market" through price reductions.
