## QUICK SNAPSHOT

### Sales



39 TOTAL SINGLE FAMILY HOMES SOLD IN JULY Sales totaled \$31 million this month, an 18% drop from last month. Very few high-dollar homes closed this month, while many low end homes that have lingered on the market finally sold.

## **Inventory**



#### **BECOMING A BROKEN RECORD**

This month we saw month over month new inventory drop and the number of pending sales increase. Last month's hope of a course correction was just an anomaly after all.

## Days on Market



One-third of the sales in July needed just 7 days or less to go into contract with a buyer. Of those, 7 sold for over-asking price, 4 sold at asking, and only two sold for less than asking price- one was to a cash buyer who closed in just 2 weeks.




## 6-Month Pricing Trends on Bainbridge



#### Median Home Price

Median: half the homes sold for more than \$660,000 and half sold for less- this is the lowest since February of this year.



## Average Home Price

Average prices vary widely every month given the range of sale prices can be millions of dollars (\$1.75M this month).


## Type of Real Estate Sold on Bainbridge

## Single Family

June was a relatively cheap month- only 20% of sales were over \$1M and 7 homes sold for under \$500K.

A 3 BR geodesic dome sold for \$479,000 and \$244/sqft. It is believed to be the only one on Bainbridge Island.

Prices per square foot this month ranged from \$135 to \$622.





FAST FACT: Two sales this month were financed by Sellers who carried back a deed of trust. A company like Bainbridge Escrow can have its attorney prepare the documents for transfer of title under the agreed upon terms of payment.


#### Most vs. Least Expensive Sales in July 2016
