OUICK SNAPSHOT

Sales



42 TOTAL SINGLE FAMILY HOMES SOLD IN JUNE Sales totaled \$38 million this month, bringing the market to \$150 million half-way through 2016. At this pace, annual sales for the year could set a new record high for sales volume.

COURSE CORRECTION!?!?

The 95 active single family homes this month was the highest in 21 months- and 57% higher than the average number of monthly active listings over that span.

Days on Market



BOLD LINE IN THE SAND

8 Days- that's the magic number. Every home sold in 8 days or less did so at or above list price. And every home sold after more than 8 days on the market did so for less than asking price.




6-Month Pricing Trends on Bainbridge



Median Home Price

Median: half the homes sold for more than \$872,000 and half sold for less- this is a new record.



Average Home Price

Average prices vary widely every month given the range of sale prices can be millions of dollars (\$1.7M this month).


Type of Real Estate Sold on Bainbridge

Single Family

June was farmhouse month: Two homes built in 1901 on the same road- New Sweden- and a 1905 barn conversion all sold within six days of each other.

A "magically secluded" home in a "natural setting" commanded 25.5% over asking priceon a loan.

Prices per square foot this month ranged from \$164 to \$560.



Raw Land Sales

A 2.4 acre lot near the riding trails of the Grand Forest, cleared and ready for equestrian use, sold for just \$298,000.

Condos

A waterfront condo in Eagle Harbor sold for \$459,000 which is \$100K less than original asking price. The HOA is facing a large maintenance bill which hurt this unit's selling price.





FAST FACT: The median home price of \$872,000 is a new record. This monthly value has only been above \$800,000 three times total, and two of those are in the last three months, the other was October of last year.

Most vs. Least Expensive Sales in June 2016




At \$2.04 million, a 5,675 sqft. home overlooking Seattle from Wing Point sold for 90.4% of its original price on the cash sale.
