#### QUICK SNAPSHOT

#### Sales



39 SINGLE FAMILY HOMES SOLD, which is uncharacteristically high for the month of October. This shows that buyer demand was strong through the end of summer, as many closings opened escrow in August and Septemer. The sales volume for October was \$34.9M.

### **Inventory**



#### SUPPLY SHORTENING UP AGAIN

Though this month had 12.5% more active listings than Oct 2015, the 81 homes is a 20% decrease from September which is far more than a typical Sep-Oct drop. Record low inventory is 53, Jan '15.

#### Days on Market



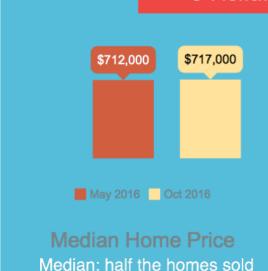
This month, one-third of sales needed less than one week to enter a contract with a buyer. A home with a delayed offer review strategy of 7 days closed for 17% over asking price.

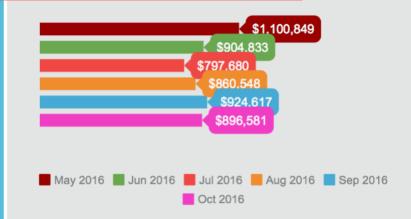


## 6-Month Pricing Trends on Bainbridge

Average prices vary widely every month given the range of sale prices can be millions of dollars (\$2.73M this month).

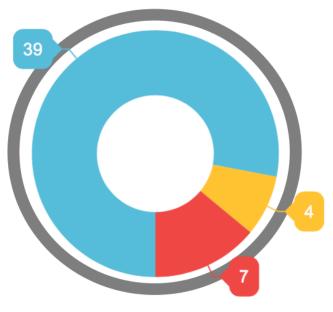

## Single Family

October's sales remind me of a warm day in July with street names such as Parkview, Sunrise, Summer Hill, Cherry, Cherry Orchard and Rose.

The commercially zoned green house on Madison by the bike shop was built in 1901 and now holds a Montessori school sold for \$630,000.

Prices per square foot this month ranged from \$205 to \$928.



#### Raw Land

A 7.6 acre lot sold around the corner from my house for \$230K. It has a private well and its property taxes are low because 6 acres are designated as open space.

#### Condos

These units did not 'fly off the shelf', but rather had an average of 41 Days on Market before finding a Buyer, and four of the seven were cash sales for an average 93% of asking price.

Single-Family (78%) Land/Lots (8%) Condos (14%)



FAST FACT: About half of homes sold at or above asking price. A million-plus cottage on 2.5 acres sold for 17% over asking price while a fantastic home on less-than-desireable Reitan Road sold for just 94% of asking price after waiting 56 days for a buyer.
